

Helping with reading at home - Daily reading

Reading homework should always be an enjoyable time for everyone involved. Below are some ideas to help your child with reading homework.

1. Talk about the pictures, the characters and the story so far.
2. Read the passage aloud with as much expression as possible.
3. Read the passage aloud again with the child joining in. The child might not manage each word but can make an attempt.
4. Read the passage aloud again together, but this time pause occasionally to allow the child to provide the next word at points where you are reasonably sure that your child will be able to carry on.
5. The child now reads the passage alone but if

she hesitates, supply the word or phrase.

6. Praise the child for joining in, for reading with expression, for supplying the right word and for effort!
